**JUDGMENT**

For the reasons set forth in the Court’s *Decision After Trial*, entered on April 17, 2012

(“**Decision**”), it is hereby ADJUDGED as follows:

1. The relief sought in the complaint (“**Complaint**”) filed by the Castillo Plaintiffs (as defined in the Decision) in the above-referenced adversary proceeding (“**Adversary Proceeding**”) is denied in its entirety.

2. The Complaint is dismissed with prejudice, and the Castillo Plaintiffs and their counsel are not entitled to any of the relief requested by them in the Adversary Proceeding.

3. The costs incurred by New GM (as defined in the Decision) in this Adversary Proceeding shall be submitted on separate application to the Court.

4. By stipulation of the parties, the allegations in New GM’s First Counterclaim and Second Counterclaim (collectively, the “**Counterclaims**”) are withdrawn, and the Court hereby dismisses the same with prejudice.

5. The Court shall retain jurisdiction, to the fullest extent permissible under law, to construe or enforce this Judgment, and/or the Decision on which it was based.
