
**RESPONSE TO DEBTORS' 192ND OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO CLAIMS SEEKING
THE ENTRY OF AN ORDER TO EXPUNGE THE DUPLICATE DEBT CLAIM OF
PHILIP JOISTEN**

1. Philip Joisten submitted a proof of claim to the court by two methods of delivery: (1) regular post and (2) registered post, which requires a signature of the addressee.
2. The two methods of delivery resulted in her single claim being mistakenly entered as two separate (duplicate) claims.
3. Philip Joisten consents to the expungement of one of these claims, Claim # 28647
